

The University has recorded that the JCR had organised several events including a winter / Christmas dinner followed by a club event and a formal Valentine's dinner. Additionally, they had been engaged with facilities regarding improving community spaces and making them more hospitable for the students.

A more expansive list of activities that the JCR carried out this year that are not recorded are as follows:

- Regular takeaway nights- where food would be ordered to the hall common room for everybody to share
- Responding to individual student requests and taking action relating to the requests
- Some details about the rugby match:
- Me and the JCR team wanted to make the match a special event for people to remember and also wanted to get the local community involved- in order to do this the team made a poster which included brief and key details about the event and the charity we are supporting- the poster included a qr code which people could scan in order to donate to the charity
- Furthermore in order to raise more money we went from door to door asking for donation around all the local businesses in the area surrounding Churchill hall covering the entirety of Whiteladies road up to park street- we would go in, introduce the charity and what the charity aims to do, we would then ask them if they would be willing to make a donation to support the rugby match and our effort to spread awareness about mental health
- After emailing Fishies (a sports night events company) we received a monetary sponsorship of £300 as well as discounted entry tickets to the club Daisy's
- We displayed the Fishies logo on our Churchill rugby kit as well and the other sponsorship's logos we had collected as part of the deal I thought of with to display their logos in exchange for sponsorship
- The non-monetary sponsorships such as vouchers were put into a raffle- which was then included as a separate ticket option to raise more money as another channel of income- there were two ticket options to the rugby match- entry to the game to spectate and entry with an included raffle for an increased price with a chance to win several prizes we had put into the raffle, both sponsorship vouchers and JCR selected vouchers
- I organised a post rugby match predrinks at the Holmes which brought together many people who came to spectate and participate in the rugby match- after the pres everyone headed to Daisy's where people were able to purchase the discounted entry tickets on the door and the club night was branded as a post Churchill vs Wills rugby match party
- A Churchill x Hiatt baker winter club night at basement 45 with student djs
- Discounted entry to the end of year black tie celebration at winestock
- Discounted entry to a valentine's event at winestock
- End of year raffle giveaway for Churchill (everyone entered automatically for free- 2 winner is each block)
- Churchill x hiatt baker north village party with student djs at Lakota
